## **Sample Responses**

**Formal (Using despite)**: The robotics club's demonstration was a success **despite** the robot's battery nearly dying and several coding errors during the show. The audience applauded their effort and creativity.

**Conversational (Using in spite of):** The robotics club's demo turned out great **in spite of** the battery almost dying and the team making a few coding mistakes. Everyone cheered for their effort and creativity.

#### Teacher's Guide

• **Skill Focus**: Helps students understand how tone shifts when choosing between **despite** (formal) and **in spite of** (conversational).

## • Differentiation Tips:

- For developing writers, provide a tone word bank (formal vs. casual) to guide vocabulary choices.
- Have advanced students add more sentence variety or transitional phrases to improve flow.

### Engagement Ideas:
