Teacher's Guide

• **Skill Focus:** Reinforces how **despite** creates a more formal tone than **in spite of** while keeping the meaning the same.

• Differentiation Tips:

- Provide examples of how small tone changes can shift writing from casual to academic (e.g., essays, reports).
- Allow struggling students to first underline the phrase in spite of before rewriting for clarity.

Engagement Ideas:

- Turn it into a "Formal Makeover Challenge" where students rephrase casual speech into academic style sentences.
- Have pairs read one version each aloud and guess which sounds more formal.

Extension Activities:

- Ask students to write their own three informal sentences using in spite
 of and then trade papers to "upgrade."
- Encourage advanced learners to combine two ideas into one polished sentence using despite effectively.
