Teacher's Guide

- **Purpose:** Strengthen students' emotional self-awareness and reflective writing skills through a real-life connection to patience.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Provide sentence starters such as "I felt impatient when...," "I stayed calm by...," or "Next time, I will...."
 - Allow students to dictate their response or share verbally before writing.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Invite students to share short excerpts anonymously for class discussion on how waiting affected them.
 - Create a "Patience Reflection Wall" where students post one sentence about what patience has taught them.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Turn the reflections into a class anthology titled "Our Lessons in Patience."
 - Encourage journaling about ongoing situations where patience is still being practiced.
