Teacher's Guide

- **Purpose:** Help students identify patient versus impatient reactions in real-life social situations.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Read scenarios aloud and have students respond verbally or with visual cards labeled "React" and "Relax."
 - For advanced learners, discuss *why* each behavior fits the category.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Role-play the scenarios, encouraging students to act out both the frustrated and calm versions.
 - Use real classroom examples (waiting turns, sharing supplies) to connect learning to daily experiences.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Have students write their own "React or Relax" situations to share with the class.
