### Teacher's Guide

- This worksheet strengthens students' ability to identify **incorrect diphthong spellings** and understand how words change meaning when vowel teams are misused. Encourage students to read each sentence aloud to hear what sounds correct.
- For learners who need additional support, review common diphthongs and provide a short reference list of correctly spelled words before beginning the activity.
- Increase engagement by letting students act as "word detectives" and use colored pencils to mark the incorrect word before rewriting the sentence.
- For extension, ask students to create their own incorrect diphthong sentence and challenge a partner to fix it. They can also highlight the correct diphthong pattern after rewriting.
