### Teacher's Guide

- Review that students should include the correct unit in every answer.
- Encourage students to estimate each quotient before solving to check whether the final answer is reasonable.
- Provide place value charts or graph paper for students who need support with decimal division.
- Ask students to explain what the quotient represents in each real-world situation, not just compute the answer.
- Have pairs compare solutions and discuss how they verified their answers using multiplication.
- Extend the activity by asking students to write their own measurement division problem involving length, mass, volume, distance, or time and exchange it with a classmate.
