- 1) A school has 300 pencils. They are packed into boxes of 10. How many boxes are needed?
- 2) Maria baked 120 cookies. She puts 10 cookies in each bag. How many bags can she fill?
- 3) A farmer collects 450 eggs. He packs them in cartons of 10. How many cartons are there?
- 4) A shopkeeper has 800 balloons. He ties them into bunches of 10. How many bunches does he make?
- 5) Liam has 3,600 marbles. He puts 10 in each jar. How many jars does he need?
- 6) A baker makes 2,500 rolls. If he packs 10 rolls in each bag, how many bags does he need?
- 7) Sarah prints 7,000 flyers. She bundles them into stacks of 10. How many stacks are made?
- 8) There are 2,400 books. If 10 books go on each shelf, how many shelves are needed?
- 9) A gardener plants 910 flowers. He arranges them in rows of 10. How many rows are there?
- 10) A factory produces 5,000 cans. They are packed into crates of 10. How many crates are filled?
- 11) A farmer harvests 1,400 apples. He puts 10 apples in each basket. How many baskets are there?
- 12) A warehouse has 9,900 boxes. They are stacked 10 per pile. How many piles are there?
- 13) Emma collects 81 seashells. She puts them into groups of 10. How many groups can she make?
- 14) A librarian has 2,200 books. She puts 10 on each display. How many displays are made?
- 15) A teacher has 75 markers. She places them into boxes of 10. How many full boxes are there?
