### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - For younger or struggling readers, read the statements aloud and discuss vocabulary words like *diyas*, *rangoli*, and *fortune*.
  - Encourage advanced students to write one new true statement about Diwali traditions they've learned.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Play a "Diwali Lights" movement game: students stand for "True" and sit for "False."
  - Display pictures of Diwali decorations and sweets for visual context before the activity.
- **Extension Activities:**
  - Have students create a short paragraph explaining how they would celebrate Diwali if they could design their own traditions.
