Sample Responses

- Ava:** Do you have any ideas for our science project?
Liam: Yes, I think we should make a volcano.
- Student:** Does the homework include the reading part too?
Teacher: Yes, it does. Please finish chapters three and four.
- Parent:** Did you clean your room yesterday?
Child: I did, and I even folded my clothes.
- Teammate 1:** Do you think we can win today?
Teammate 2: We do if we stay focused and play hard.
- Ben:** Does Mia bring the snacks for the party?
Ella: No, she doesn't. I did last time, so it's your turn!

Teacher's Guide

- **Objective:** Students practice using **do**, **does**, and **did** correctly in real-world conversation through creative dialogue writing.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Provide verb usage reminders: *do/does* for present and *did* for past.
 - For struggling learners, offer partially completed dialogues to fill in.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Have pairs perform their dialogues for the class to practice speaking fluently.
 - Play "Dialogue Switch," where students swap scripts and read each other's aloud.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to expand one dialogue into a full story or comic strip.
 - Encourage advanced learners to include questions, answers, and tag lines ("don't you," "didn't we") naturally in their dialogues.
