### Teacher's Guide

- **Objective:** Students identify and create sentences using **do** and **did** for **emphasis**, strengthening their understanding of tone and emphasis in English grammar.
- **Differentiation Tips:**

  - For struggling learners, model examples aloud so they can hear the difference between regular and emphatic use.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Have students perform "mini drama lines" where they emphasize **do/did** in expressive sentences.
  - Turn it into a "Tone Detective" game-students guess whether a sentence is emphatic or normal based on your delivery.
- **Extension Activities:**
  - Ask students to find examples of emphasis in books, shows, or conversations and share them in class.
  - Challenge advanced learners to rewrite sentences from their own writing by adding emphasis naturally and meaningfully.
