Teacher's Guide

- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Have a "Verb Fix Contest" where students race to fix sentences correctly on the board.
 - Let students create a mini comic strip showing one character who "does," another who "do," and a third who "did."
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to write five original sentences using all three verbs correctly.
 - Challenge advanced learners to explain **why** each correction is needed.
