Teacher's Guide

Skill Focus:

- Students identify **incorrect use of doubled consonants** and correct them based on the CVC doubling rule or standard spelling.
- Encourages close reading and builds proofreading skills.

Differentiation Tips:

- Offer highlighting strips to help emerging readers spot the base word.
- Provide a mini reference list of common doubled words for students who need extra support.
- Challenge advanced students to explain why each word does or does not follow the doubling rule.

Engagement Ideas:

- Turn this into a partner editing game where students take turns identifying and correcting errors aloud.
- Put incorrect doubled words on cards and let students sort them into **correct with doubling** and **incorrect or irregular** piles.
