### Teacher's Guide

#### Teaching Focus:

- Strengthens understanding of how **each** focuses on individuals and **every** emphasizes a group or repeated actions.
- Reinforces subject-verb agreement when using these determiners.
- Suitable for Grades **6-7**, blending grammar practice with decision-making skills.

#### Differentiation Tips:

- For struggling learners: Review the basic rule that **each** often pairs with "of" while **every** does not.
- For advanced learners: Ask them to explain how changing **each** to **every** (or vice versa) slightly alters the meaning.

#### Engagement Ideas:

- Have students debate tricky sentences in pairs before revealing answers.
- Turn it into a quick grammar quiz race-students hold up cards for A or B to show their answers.

#### Extension Activities:

- Ask students to create their own pair of similar sentences, one correct and one incorrect, and challenge classmates to choose.
- Have them write a short paragraph using both **each** and **every** correctly to demonstrate mastery.
