Edited Passage

Teacher's Guide

Teaching Focus:

- Strengthens understanding of how **each** applies to individual members of a group, while **every** refers to all members collectively or repeatedly.
- Encourages contextual reasoning within an authentic informational passage.
- Best suited for Grades **7-8**, building editing and grammatical precision skills.

Differentiation Tips:

- For struggling learners: Highlight all determiners first, then decide if they describe individuals (**each**) or groups (**every**).
- For advanced learners: Ask them to explain *why* they made each correction and how it affects the meaning of the sentence.

Extension Activities:

- Have students write their own short paragraph about a school event using both **each** and **every** correctly at least twice.
- Provide a flawed paragraph written by a peer or AI and let students identify and fix the incorrect determiners as editors.
