Teacher's Guide

Teaching Focus:

- Builds mastery of **each** (refers to individuals) and **every** (refers to groups or repeated actions).
- Perfect for Grades **4-5** as a skill review or short quiz.

Differentiation Tips:

- For struggling learners: Have them read the sentences aloud and think about whether the action is done *individually* (**each**) or *as a group or routine* (**every**).
- For advanced learners: Encourage them to rewrite two sentences using the alternate determiner and explain how the meaning changes.

Engagement Ideas:

- Turn the activity into a "Determiner Duel" where students compete in pairs to choose the correct word first.
- Read sentences aloud and have the class vote with raised hands for "each" or "every."

Extension Activities:

- Ask students to create a short paragraph using **each** and **every** correctly at least once.
- Challenge them to find examples of **each** and **every** in a book or article and explain how they are used.
