Sample Responses

Definitions and sentences will vary. Below are examples for teacher reference.

- 1. **Resurrection** The act of coming back to life; Jesus' rising from the dead. *Sentence:* The resurrection symbolizes hope and new beginnings for believers.
- 2. **Sacrifice** Giving up something valuable for the good of others. *Sentence:* The Easter story teaches about love shown through sacrifice.
