Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Figurative language, idiom recognition, and contextual sentence creation.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For younger or developing readers, discuss each idiom's literal image first (e.g., eggs in a basket) before explaining its figurative meaning.
 - For advanced learners, challenge them to find idioms in literature or create new ones inspired by springtime.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Create a "Classroom Basket of Idioms" wall display with eggs labeled with phrases and meanings.
 - Use idioms in daily warm-ups - one idiom per day with short writing prompts.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Have students write short dialogues using at least three idioms naturally.
