## Hoppy Path Practice Answer Key

This is a tracing activity; correct answers show **smooth, continuous lines** following each path without crossing outside the line boundaries. Focus is on neatness, direction, and grip control rather than speed.

### Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Fine motor coordination, pencil control, and prewriting line formation.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - For beginners, use thick markers or crayons for easier grip and smoother tracing.
  - For advanced students, challenge them to trace backward or color the bunny and carrot afterward.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Make the worksheet tactile-students can trace with their fingers before using a pencil.
  - Encourage sound effects or "bunny hops" while tracing each path to build rhythm and focus.
- **Extension Activities:**
  - Add short sight words (like *hop*, *run*, *eat*) along each path to introduce early literacy while tracing.
  - Create a story: "Where will the bunny hop next?" and let students draw their own path to another object (flower, egg, or chick).
