Teacher Notes/Guide

- **Tips for Instruction:**
 - Have students label what is missing (subject, verb, or complete idea).
 - Encourage multiple revisions. Creativity is welcome as long as it's grammatically correct.
 - Reading sentences aloud often reveals when an idea feels unfinished.
- **Extension Idea:** Give students a short passage with both fragments and complete sentences. Their task: identify and repair only the fragments.
