Teacher Notes/Guide

- **Tips for Instruction:**
 - Encourage students to use spelling strategies: sound it out, look for root words, use memory tricks.
 - Reinforce checking with a dictionary or spell-check tool when in doubt.
 - After correcting, have students **circle the fixed word** in their corrected sentence for emphasis.
