### Corrected Sentences:

1. Yesterday we **walked** to the park and **saw** ducks.
2. My friend **plays** video games after school every **day**.
3. "**Can I borrow your pencil?**" she asked.
4. The **dogs ran** across the **field** fast.
5. **We are** going to the movies later. **Do** you want to come?
6. It's raining **heavily**, so **don't** forget your umbrella.
7. The teacher **said** that the test **is** tomorrow.
8. **Wow!** That pizza looks delicious!
9. **He and I have been** best friends since kindergarten.
10. Please **shut** the window before you **leave**.

### Teacher Notes/Guide:

- **Types of Errors Covered:** verb tense (walk → walked, see → saw), subject-verb agreement (friend play → friend plays), plurals (every days → every day), capitalization, punctuation (dialogue and exclamations), contractions (Its → It's, dont → don't), irregular verbs (say → said, runned → ran), homophones (feild → field), and word form corrections (raining heavy → raining heavily).
- **Instructional Strategy:** Encourage students to read the sentence aloud, since hearing the mistake often helps them spot it. Provide mini-lessons after reviewing answers to reinforce each error type.
