### Teacher Notes/Guide

- **Focus Areas:** Names (Mia, Sophia, Emma), Places (Chicago, Washington, D.C., Central Park), Titles (*Charlotte's Web*, *The Lion King*, *Harry Potter*), and Official Titles (Principal Brown, Coach Williams).
- **Common Student Pitfalls:** forgetting to capitalize days of the week, book/movie titles, and official names of landmarks.
- **Tip:** After students correct sentences, ask them to explain *why* each word needed capitalization. This reinforces the reasoning instead of simple correction.
