### Sample Responses

1. Either option works, as long as we can finish the project before the deadline.
2. Neither answer makes sense because the question was misunderstood by the class.
3. You can call either number if you need help after office hours.
4. Neither road is safe when heavy rain floods the valley.
5. Either shirt fits, though the blue one matches your shoes better.
6. Neither idea will succeed unless we gather more support from the team.
7. Either snack is fine since both are healthy and quick to prepare.
8. Neither choice seems easy because both require a lot of effort and patience.
9. You may pick either seat, but remember the back row has a better view.
10. Neither of them spoke while the teacher waited for an answer.

### Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Develops students' ability to integrate **either** and **neither** into more advanced sentence structures while maintaining correct agreement and logical flow.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - Provide sentence starters or conjunctions (e.g., *because, although, unless, since*) for students who need scaffolding.
  - Encourage advanced learners to expand with compound-complex structures that include multiple clauses.
- **Engagement Idea:** Turn the exercise into a "Sentence Stretch" contest where students share the most creative, grammatically accurate expansions aloud.
- **Extension Activity:** Ask students to take their expanded sentences and combine two into a short paragraph that compares or contrasts the situations they describe, ensuring correct use of **either** and **neither**.
