Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Strengthens students' ability to identify and correct incorrect uses of **either** and **neither**, emphasizing context and sentence meaning.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Model two example corrections together to show how meaning changes when determiners are swapped.
 - Allow struggling students to underline the problem word before rewriting to simplify the task.
- **Engagement Idea:** Create a "Fix-It Relay" where teams race to correct misused sentences on the board.
- **Extension Activity:** Ask students to write their own three pairs of sentences- one correct, one incorrect- and exchange with a partner for correction.
