

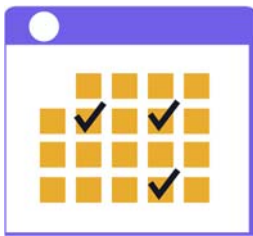

5. A family vacation starts at **5:10 PM on Saturday** and ends at **2:35 PM on Monday**. How long was it?
6. A science project begins at **11:50 AM on Monday** and finishes at **9:20 PM on Tuesday**. How long did it take?
7. A school play rehearsal begins at **7:45 PM on Thursday** and ends at **6:30 PM on Friday**. How long did it last?
