Ranking Tiny Faces for Big Thinking

Emojis might look small, but they pack *major* meaning. A single swap can change a whole mood - turning a dramatic scene into a joke or a silly idea into something surprisingly deep. In this activity, you'll look at sets of emoji "mini-stories" and decide how to rank them: from **most happy to most serious**, or **most creative to most realistic** (your teacher will tell you which category to use).

Your job is to be a meaning detective - look closely, think about tone and story, and explain *why* you ranked them the way you did. This helps you practice reading between the (emoji) lines, a skill that's super useful for understanding context, tone, and subtle meaning.

How to Play - Look at each group of emoji sequences below. Rank them in order (1 = most ____, 4 = least ____). Explain *why* you placed them in that order - what clues helped you decide?

Example: Category: Most Happy → Most Serious
