1. Betrayed - Hurt by someone you trusted.
2. Apprehensive - Nervous or unsure about what might happen.
3. Exhilarated - Extremely excited or thrilled.
4. Resentful - Angry or bitter about something unfair.
5. Terrified - Extremely scared.
6. Humiliation - Deep embarrassment or shame.
7. Dismay - Shocked disappointment or sadness.

Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Read sentences aloud and emphasize tone to help students infer meaning.
 - Provide simpler synonyms next to complex emotion words for emerging readers.
 - Allow oral responses for students with writing difficulties.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn the activity into a "Detective Game" where students explain their reasoning using context clues.
 - Have students act out the emotions to show understanding before writing definitions.
 - Create emotion clue cards for group discussions.
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Ask students to write their own sentence using each new emotion word.
 - Encourage students to find other examples of these words in books or media.
 - Build an "Advanced Feelings Wall" featuring each word, its meaning, and a student-made drawing or example.
