Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Read each scenario aloud and model thinking aloud ("What clues tell me this feeling fits?").
 - Provide visual aids showing facial expressions for each emotion choice.
 - Offer simplified answer sets for emerging readers with only two options per question.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Use emotion cards to let students act out each feeling before answering.
 - Have students work in pairs to explain why they chose their answers.
 - Encourage students to relate each scenario to a time they felt that emotion.
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Invite students to write their own multiple-choice question about an emotion.
 - Turn the quiz into a classroom "Feelings Game Show" for review.
 - Create a follow-up discussion on how to manage each emotion in healthy ways.
