Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Provide picture clues beside each emotion for visual learners.
 - Read passages aloud and discuss the emotions before students write.
 - Allow students to use emotion word cards to match words before writing.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Have students act out each passage after completing it.
 - Let students work in pairs to explain why they chose each emotion.
 - Play "Emotion Charades" using the same words from the word bank.
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Ask students to write a new short story using three of the emotion words.
 - Encourage journal reflections about times they have felt each emotion.
 - Create an "Emotion of the Week" corner featuring student examples and drawings.
