### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - Read each pair aloud and provide context sentences for students who need more support.
  - Offer visual cards showing opposite emotion faces to aid comprehension.
  - Allow students to use a personal emotion vocabulary chart as a reference tool.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Play "Emotion Match" where students physically move to opposite corners for synonyms or opposites.
  - Encourage small group discussions where students explain their reasoning.
  - Use real-life examples ("When you're relaxed, are you feeling the same or opposite of nervous?").
- **Extension Ideas:**
  - Have students create their own synonym and opposite pairs using emotion words.
  - Challenge students to write short sentences using both words in a pair.
  - Create a classroom "Emotion Wall" divided into synonyms and opposites for continued vocabulary practice.
