Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips**

- Model one example on the board, showing how the two parts blend smoothly together.
- Provide a list of common ending blends for students who need visual reminders.
- Allow advanced learners to create and solve their own blend equations using new word parts.

- **Engagement Ideas**

- Turn equations into a partner challenge where students read each half aloud before blending.
- Have students clap once for the base part and twice for the ending blend before saying the full word.

- **Extension Activities**

- Invite students to write a short sentence using two of their completed equation words.
- Ask students to sort completed words by ending blend, reinforcing visual pattern recognition.
