- 6. hunt  $\rightarrow$  punt, runt
- 7. jump  $\rightarrow$  bump, slump, stump
- 8. wind  $\rightarrow$  find, mind, kind
- 9. belt → melt, pelt, felt
- 10. lamp  $\rightarrow$  camp, ramp, damp

#### Teacher's Guide

### Differentiation Tips

- Provide a list of approved ending blends (mp, nd, lt, nt, st) for reference if students need support.
- Say the ending blend aloud and ask students to brainstorm beginning sounds before writing.
- Allow advanced learners to create three different new words per item instead of one.

## • Engagement Ideas

- Turn the activity into a quick oral game where students pass a ball and say a new switch-a-sound word each turn.
- Have partners check each other's words to confirm they are real and spelled with the same blend.

#### Extension Activities

- Ask students to choose their favorite new word and draw a labeled picture of it.
- Invite students to build a short silly sentence using two of their new blend words.
