## Christmas Blend Questions Answer Key

Note: Answers will vary. Samples provided below.

Students must include at least one ending blend word from the passage such as: tent, wind, blink, lamp, print, bump, jumped, crisp.

1. They set up their **tent** by the pine tree.
2. They hoped to hear the soft **wind**.
3. They **jumped** because they felt a **bump** behind the tent.
4. They were holding the **gift** and getting ready to **print** a name on it.

### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips**

- Read the passage aloud once before students attempt the questions.
- Highlight or list the ending blend words in the passage for students who need visual support.
- Encourage emerging writers to use sentence frames such as: They heard the \_\_\_\_\_. They jumped because \_\_\_\_\_.

- **Engagement Ideas**

- Have students act out one blend word from the passage and let the class guess which one it is.
- Let students reread the passage with a partner, taking turns emphasizing the ending blends.

- **Extension Activities**

- Ask students to rewrite the ending of the passage using at least three new ending blend words.
- Invite students to draw the scene and label at least four objects or actions with blend words.
