## Digraph Rule Sort Answer Key

**Short vowel + ck**: duck, snack, stick

**Short vowel + tch**: match, fetch, hutch

Nasal + ng/nk: sing, bank, wing, branch (ends in nch but follows nasal n + ch), lunch (same pattern), rang

## Teacher's Guide

- This worksheet helps students notice spelling rules that guide when to use ck, tch, and ng/nk patterns.
- Support learners by reviewing that ck usually follows a short vowel, tch often follows a short vowel, and ng/nk follow a nasal n sound.
- For differentiation, provide a small sound box where students tap out vowels before choosing a rule. Challenge advanced students by having them add two new words to each category from memory.
- For engagement, let students work in partners to read the word list aloud and sort them physically on slips of paper before writing their final answers.
