Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Developing awareness of **social timing**, **entry phrases**, **exit phrases**, and **nonverbal communication** during group interactions.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Provide visuals of open vs. closed body language to reinforce understanding.
 - Offer sentence starters for polite entry and exit ("Can I join you?" "Thanks for the talk!").
 - Allow verbal responses or small-group practice for students who struggle with reading comprehension.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn this quiz into a role-play game where students act out correct and incorrect choices.
 - Discuss real-life school situations where joining or leaving politely matters (group projects, lunch tables, online chats).
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Have students write a short reflection on a time they joined or left a group politely.
 - Use a "Social Flow Chart" to illustrate when to enter or exit conversations based on visual and verbal cues.
