Esperanza's Missing Chapter

Directions: Authors sometimes leave readers wondering what else could have happened in a story. In this activity, you will imagine and write a "**lost chapter**" of *Esperanza Rising*; a scene that could fit naturally into the novel but is not included.

Follow these steps:

- 1. Choose a Spot in the Story: Decide where your "lost chapter" could be added (e.g., before the fire, during the train ride, while Mama is sick, or after Abuelita arrives).
- 2. Create a Title: Give your chapter a title that captures its main idea.
- 3. Write the Scene: Describe the event. Use sensory details (what Esperanza sees, hears, feels) and dialogue to make it realistic.
- 4. Connect to Themes: End your chapter with a sentence that shows how the event connects to one of the novel's themes (resilience, hope, family, or social justice).
