Teacher's Guide

Purpose: This worksheet helps Grades 3 to 5 students recognize major European landforms and classify them into correct geographic categories.

Teaching Tips

- Review the meaning of mountain, river, and peninsula before beginning.
- Model the sorting of one example to demonstrate the process.
- Encourage students to think about word clues like endings or known locations.

Differentiation

- Provide images or short definitions for students who need extra support.
- Let advanced students add one more example to each category from their prior knowledge or a classroom map.
- Offer the option to sort using colored highlighters for visual learners.

Engagement Ideas

- After sorting, invite students to choose one landform and share something interesting they know or imagine about it.
- Use a wall map and have students place sticky notes for each feature in the correct region.

Extension Activities

- Students create a simple illustrated mini map that labels one mountain range, one river, and one peninsula from the list.
- Challenge students to research one additional European landform and present one fact to the class.
