Teacher's Guide

Purpose: This worksheet helps Grades 3 to 5 students recognize major European landmarks by connecting simple descriptions to well known places.

Teaching Tips

- Review what a landmark is before starting.
- Read each description aloud and ask students which clues stand out.
- Encourage students to picture the places in their minds as they think.

Differentiation

- Provide a small word bank for students needing extra support.
- Let advanced students write one additional description and have classmates guess the landmark.
- Offer visual cue cards for students who benefit from picture support.

Engagement Ideas

- Show brief images after the activity to confirm student guesses and spark discussion.
- Invite students to vote on which landmark they would most like to visit.

Extension Activities

- Students create a postcard style drawing of one landmark with a short fact about it.
- Have students research one lesser known European landmark and show it to the class.
