Understanding the European Union

The European Union is a group of European countries that work together to make shared decisions about things that affect the region. It began as a way to help countries trade more easily and avoid conflicts by encouraging cooperation. Today, the EU focuses on many areas such as the environment, travel, trade, and human rights.

One important feature of the EU is that many of its members use a shared currency called the euro. This makes it easier for people to buy goods, travel, and do business across different countries. The EU also allows citizens of its member nations to move freely between countries for work or study. Even though the countries share responsibilities, each nation still keeps its own government and laws. The purpose of the EU is not to make countries identical but to support unity while respecting differences.
