Teacher's Guide

Purpose: This worksheet introduces Grades 3 to 5 students to key ideas about Europe using a simple reading passage and comprehension questions.

Teaching Tips

- Ask students to picture the landscapes mentioned and share what they imagine.
- Encourage students to underline unfamiliar words and discuss them as a class.

Engagement Ideas

- Show pictures of the Eiffel Tower, Colosseum, or European landscapes after the worksheet to build connections.
- Invite students to share any European foods or traditions they have heard of.

Extension Activities

- Have students write a short paragraph about a European country they want to visit and why.
- Ask students to create a postcard illustration of one European landmark mentioned in the passage.
