Teacher's Guide

- Allow students to use a map or classroom atlas for support.
- Challenge advanced students to correct each false statement in full sentence form.

Engagement Ideas

- After the worksheet, show photos of the Alps, Danube River, and major landmarks to reinforce learning.
- Let students vote on which European place mentioned they would most like to visit.
