Teacher's Guide

- Quick implementation: Remind students to multiply quantity by unit price, then add any shipping or delivery charge before comparing vendors.
- Differentiation: Let students who need support underline unit prices and circle extra fees before calculating.
- Engagement: Have students act as purchasing managers responsible for choosing the lower-cost supplier for each order.
- Extension: Ask students to calculate how much money the business saves by choosing the cheaper vendor in each problem.
