The Empty Chair Answer Key

Possible Implied Answers:

- 1. The student who normally sits there was absent.
- 2. The student could be sick, late, or skipping class.
- The absent student might feel worried about missing the quiz or relieved to avoid it.
- 4. Ms. Lopez may have been frustrated, concerned, or disappointed that the student missed the quiz.
- 5. A classmate might assume the student was ill, had an appointment, or chose not to come.

Teacher Notes:

- Stress that any implied detail must connect back to explicit clues in the
 passage (e.g., the empty chair + the quiz = someone is missing an
 assessment).
- Encourage students to provide evidence ("She sighed" = disappointment).
- Extension: Ask students to write a short continuation of the story showing what happens when the absent student returns.
