Model Answers

- He was returning overdue books. (The fact he paid money and received a slip suggests he had late fees.)
- 2. **To pay a fine for the books**. (The crumpled dollar and coins show a payment transaction.)
- 3. The librarian was probably pleased or approving. (She smiled and nodded, suggesting friendliness or satisfaction.)
- 4. It was likely a receipt or record of payment. (The librarian handed him the slip after scanning and payment.)
- 5. **Because he "hurried out the door."** (The text explicitly says he hurried, showing urgency.)

Teacher Notes:

- Highlight how every inference is supported by text clues (e.g., money + slip
 library fine).
- Ask students to point out which exact words in the passage led them to their answer.
- Extension: Have students write one additional "why" or "how" question about the passage and answer it with their own inference.
