Sample Answers:

Implied Answer: He was nervous because he was late.
Explicit Proof: "Jordan slipped inside, glancing nervously at the clock."

Implied Answer: He wasn't very prepared for class.
Explicit Proof: "His notebook was half open, with pages bent from being stuffed into his backpack."

Implied Answer: They found his entrance amusing.
Explicit Proof: "A few students giggled quietly."

Implied Answer: He wanted to avoid the teacher's attention.
Explicit Proof: "He avoided looking at Ms. Rivera and slid quickly into his seat."

Teacher Notes:

- Stress that every inference must be tied to direct text evidence.
- Encourage students to use quotation marks properly when citing explicit proof.
- Extension: Have students write one new implied question about the passage, then answer it with both an implied conclusion and an explicit quote.
