Matches:

- $1 \rightarrow D$. Daniel felt rushed because of the bad weather. (Walking quickly in heavy rain shows urgency.)
- $2 \rightarrow C$. Daniel did not have an umbrella of his own. (Noticing the umbrella and picking it up shows he needed one.)
- $3 \rightarrow$ E. The umbrella had been used recently. (Water dripping suggests recent use.)
- $4 \rightarrow B$. The umbrella belonged to someone who had left it behind. (No one around but an umbrella left.)
- $5 \rightarrow$ A. Daniel was relieved to find some protection from the rain. (His smile shows relief.)

Teacher Notes:

- This activity trains students to connect direct text evidence with logical inferences.
- Encourage students to explain why they paired each clue and inference (e.g., "He smiled after picking it up, which shows he was relieved").
- Extension: Have students write one new implied statement and identify the
 explicit clue that supports it.
