Teacher's Guide

- Review the exponent property names before students begin so the vocabulary is familiar.
- Encourage students to simplify each expression first, then identify which property explains the simplification.
- Provide a reference chart of exponent properties for students who need additional support.
- Have students work in pairs and explain why each property matches its expression before checking answers.
- Increase engagement by cutting the three lists into cards and letting students physically sort and match the sets.
- Extend learning by asking students to create one new expression for each exponent property and exchange it with a partner to match and solve.
