Rubric for Scoring (Total: 15 points)

- **Precision (5 points):** Each determiner is used correctly in context and shows clear understanding of quantity and tone.
- **Tone (5 points):** The paragraph reflects how the choice of determiner changes the emotional tone (negative, hopeful, or specific).
- **Clarity (5 points):** Sentences are well-organized, connected, and easy to follow.
