Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Helps students distinguish between **few** (almost none), **a few** (some, a small number), and **the few** (a specific limited group).
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Provide extra oral examples for visual learners (e.g., show three apples to represent "a few").
 - Allow struggling students to create mini sentences with each determiner before completing the worksheet.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Have students write two short original sentences using each determiner to show understanding.
 - Encourage partner discussion-students explain why they chose their answers.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Assign a paragraph-writing task describing a team or event using all three forms correctly.
 - Ask students to find examples of these determiners in a magazine article or short story for homework.
