Best choice: *The few* (emphasizes a dedicated small group).

3. Few fans cheered for the team even after it lost.

A few fans cheered for the team even after it lost.

The few fans who stayed loyal cheered loudly until the end.

Best choice: A few (shows optimism and loyalty).

4. Few people attended the local poetry night despite the rain.

A few people attended the local poetry night despite the rain.

The few people who came enjoyed a cozy, quiet evening.

Best choice: A few (balances small turnout with positivity).

5. Few classmates submitted their science fair projects early.

A few classmates submitted their science fair projects early.

The few classmates who submitted early were praised by the teacher.

Best choice: *The few* (indicates specific recognition).

Extension Activities:

- Ask students to apply this technique to a paragraph from literature or a news article.
- Challenge advanced learners to craft an original short paragraph using all three determiners intentionally to show tone progression.
